## **Coming Together for Positive Change**

Fund a Project offers a terrific opportunity for your group to bring about positive change for an entire ChildFund community.

Here are just a few examples of projects that are available or have recently been funded:

- Playground equipment for parks in Afghanistan
- Restrooms for an elementary school in Mexico
- Supplies for a community garden in the United States
- Malaria prevention program in Zambia
- Community health huts in Senegal
- Water purification kits for families living with HIV/AIDS in Uganda
- Youth employment and livelihood initiatives needed globally

These projects typically require several thousand dollars to fund. Yet, when people come together for a great cause, they can be implemented quickly.

After choosing your project, you'll want to publicize it to your group through your regular communications and social media. You may wish to publicize your efforts through the local media and invite the public to contribute to the project.

Include the website link and the brief project description in all of your communications.

Watch the fundraising thermometer rise on the ChildFund website as donations come in. Report back to your group when you reach key milestones (e.g., first \$1,000 raised, half-way point, the final push to get over the top). Keep up the fundraising momentum.

Each contributor will receive a report from ChildFund when the project is implemented.

Your group will have the satisfaction of knowing you've made a huge difference in the lives of children who now have a safe place to play or better healthcare as a result of your collective efforts.
