## Anne Lynam Goddard to Retire After 15 Years as ChildFund International President and CEO; Board Announces Executive Search

**Richmond, Virginia | May 27, 2021** ChildFund International has announced that Anne Lynam Goddard will retire in May 2022 after 15 years of leading the organization.

Goddard began her career in the Peace Corps in Kenya. After earning a master's degree in public health from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, she joined the international humanitarian organization CARE and lived and worked overseas for almost 20 years.

She joined ChildFund as its eighth president and CEO in 2007, guiding the child-focused global nonprofit's efforts to help vulnerable children find and create greater opportunity, hope and self-sufficiency. Building on the organization's 80-year history, Goddard went on to lead a strategy that expanded and deepened ChildFund's worldwide efforts to advance child protection and improve children's health, education and economic conditions.

"Anne's strong leadership over the last 15 years positioned ChildFund to rise to the challenges of last year and continue vital services to vulnerable children as the global pandemic threatened to reverse decades of gains for the world's children," says Lyn McDermid, ChildFund's board chair. "Her fierce commitment to justice for children, combined with her deep understanding of what it takes for them to achieve their potential, continually drove ChildFund to aim ever higher in impact, efficiency and quality."

"It has been the honor of my life to serve ChildFund these last 15 years," says Goddard. "I never imagined myself as a CEO – I just wanted to make a difference in the world. When I saw firsthand the terrible injustices so many children are born into, I knew I had found my passion, which ultimately led me to ChildFund, and I'm so grateful. It's the right time for ChildFund to seek new leadership. Personally, I am excited to explore new avenues where I might continue contributing to helping children and communities thrive."
